The term of this Agreement is thirty-six (36) months from the date of the contract acceptance as indicated by the institutional signature and date.

For every three months that the student goes beyond the DA Capstone Project deadline and does not submit a completed Project and final, edited Project Report, a two-thousand dollar fee will be assessed. After the second late project fee assessment, the doctoral committee will be dissolved and the student will be required to restart their clock, form a new committee, and pay the additional Doctoral Project Fee of \$3500.

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

Satisfaction Policy: If for any reason you choose to discontinue your studies, Viridis Graduate Institute has established this cancellation and refund policy for your protection. Viridis Graduate Institute's refund and cancellation policies conform to the requirements of the Arizona State Board for Private Postsecondary Education (R4-39-404), with the institution's accrediting body, the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC).

Five-Day Cancellation: An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within **five (5) days** (excluding Saturday, Sunday and federal and state holidays) of signing this enrollment Agreement is entitled to a refund of all monies paid. No later than 30 days of receiving the notice of cancellation, the school shall provide the 100% refund.

Other Cancellations: An applicant requesting cancellation more than **five (5) days** after signing an enrollment Agreement and making an initial payment, but prior to entering the school, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, minus the online Application Fee of \$100.00.

TIME BASED REFUND: Refund after the commencement of classes:

1. Procedure for withdrawal/withdrawal date:
 - A. A student choosing to withdraw from the school after the commencement of classes is to provide written notice to the Office of the Registrar (vgi.registrar@viridis.edu). The notice is to indicate the expected last date of attendance and be signed and dated by the student. All completed credits must be paid in full before a Withdrawal is finalized.
 - B. A student on an authorized Leave of Absence, the withdraw date is the date the student was scheduled to return from the Leave and failed to do so.
 - C. A student will be determined to be withdrawn from the institution if the student has not attended any class for three (3) weeks out of the ten (10) week program.
 - D. All applicable refunds will be issued within 30 days of the determination of the withdrawal date.

2. Tuition charges/refunds:
 - A. Before the beginning of classes, the student is entitled to a refund of 100% of the tuition, minus the online Application Fee of \$100.00.
 - B. After the commencement of classes, the tuition refund, minus the online Application Fee of \$100.00 will be determined as follows:

Sample Refund Calculation

In the first quarter, each course is 3 credits at \$230 per credit = \$690 per course. All refund examples below assume that the student has paid course in full prior to beginning of the class start.

Viridis Graduate Institute Right to Cancel
